Key Figures¹: (Canada Total Population: 35,184,731)

- Total “indigenous identity” population: 1.81 million (5% of Canada’s population)
- Total **off-reserve** population: 1.48 million, *or 82%*, out of 1.81 million total Indigenous peoples in Canada.
- Total **non-status (not a registered or treaty Indian)** population: 975,530, *or 54%*, out of 1.81 million total Indigenous peoples in Canada.
 - Among **First Nations population**, 295,290, *or 28%*, out of 1,048,405 total First Nations population are non-status.
 - Among **Métis population**, 585, 105, *or 93%*, out of the 624,220 total Metis population in Canada are non-status.
- Among **Metis population**, 453, 830, *or 73%*, out of 624,220 total Metis population are not part of one of the five signatory organizations to the Canada–Métis Nation Accord nor living in an Alberta Metis settlement²
- Among the **Inuit population**, 21,825, *or 31%*, out of the 70, 540 total Inuit population in Canada are living outside/south of Inuit Nunangat.
